Vox Clamantis is an internationally renowned Gregorian chant ensemble, touring regularly in Europe and beyond, sometimes together with Le Chœur Grégorien de Paris.

The Weekend Guitar Trio's composed/improvised music for three electric guitars and live electronics has captivated both jazz and classical contemporary music audiences in many countries.

Both groups collaborate with modern composers (Vox Clamantis is particularly proud of its connection with **Arvo Pärt**) and with musicians from other traditions. In 2007, joint concerts in the UK by Vox Clamantis and the Tunisian oud player Dhafer Youssef were critically acclaimed (. . .a hauntingly beautiful fusion of their disparate traditions.
